

in a survey conducted by the ASCSI Senate and the Magic Valley Tobacco Free Coalition, 960 respondents representing all stakeholders of the institution supported the creation of a smoke-free environment by a majority and

90% of the 960 respondents also indicated that they wanted CSI to do more to limit their exposure to second hand smoke and

over 90% of colleges and universities nationwide have adopted smoke-free policies and CSI could set the example for the creation of a healthy, smoke-free, public campus in Idaho, and

CSI is promoting a healthy lifestyle and environment, the effects of second hand smoke and the accompanying litter run contrary to that purpose and,

the College and South Central Public Health District will offer free classes, activities, and incentives to support the efforts of individuals to quit smoking,
